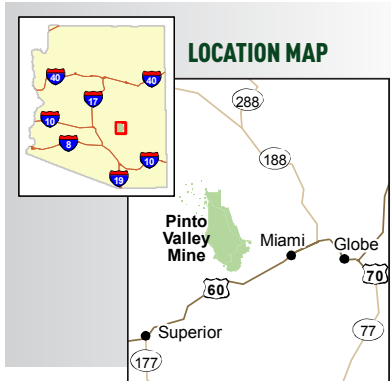

ENVIRONMENTAL IMPACT STATEMENT

Draft EIS Available for Comment

On December 13, 2019, the Tonto National Forest published a notice of availability for the Pinto Valley Mine draft environmental impact statement (EIS) in the Federal Register. The Tonto National Forest is seeking input on the draft EIS. Refer to the back side of this postcard for information on how to submit comments and attend public meetings hosted by the Forest Service. Written comments will be accepted for a 45-day public comment period from December 13, 2019 to January 27, 2020.

Background: The Pinto Valley Mine is an existing open pit copper and molybdenum mine located approximately 8 miles west of Miami, Arizona in Gila County. Pinto Valley Mining Corp. is proposing to further expand mining activities onto the Tonto National Forest, extend the mine life to 2039, and to consolidate previous and ongoing authorizations for the mine. This draft EIS evaluates and discloses the potential environmental effects from the Forest Service's approval of the mining plan of operations.
